Honda Manufacturing Plant Tour Guidelines

Please observe the following guidelines and share with your guest(s) prior to your event date:

- Admission and parking are free.
- Guests must be in 7th grade and up to participate in the manufacturing plant tour.
- **Adults will need a government issued photo identification (driver's license, passport, etc.) for check-in upon arrival.**
- The manufacturing plant tour portion is physically demanding as it is a fast-paced, one-hour walking tour (approx. 1.5 miles) that may include stairs. If you require accommodations (i.e. wheelchair, etc.), please bring your own.
- All tours start at the Honda Heritage Center (museum) and will include either a tour of the Marysville Auto Plant or the East Liberty Auto Plant.
- Guests will visit the museum first and will, then, advance to the auto plant in their personal vehicle.
- **Please wear comfortable walking shoes for the plant tour. Shoes must cover the foot and heel. Sandals, open-toe or open-back shoes are prohibited.**
- **Skirts/shorts must be knee length or longer for the auto plant tour.**
- Honda does not allow any tour participant to leave any type of marketing, solicitation, or sales materials at any of our facilities.
- You are welcome to bring your personal ear buds and/or safety glasses for the auto plant tour; if not, these items will be provided by Honda.
- Please come prepared for inclement weather as there will be some walking outdoors to and from parking areas.

- In cases of emergency, Honda reserves the right to cancel plant tours up to the day of the tour.
