- **Operation Full Belly**

Many families in Athens County face significant challenges meeting their basic needs, with hunger being one of the most urgent concerns. According to the USDA, Athens County has one of the highest food insecurity rates in Ohio, with 20.4% of residents unsure where their next meal will come from. Operation Full Belly, supported largely by the Athens County DJFS Community Cares Fund, the Rocky Community Improvement Fund, and private donations, addresses this critical need. The program provides emergency food bags to individuals who may not qualify for USDA-mandated food pantry assistance, have experienced issues like EBT card skimming, or face emergent needs.

- **Back To School Bash (BTSB)**

Since 2019, Back To School Bash has provided clothing, shoes, school supplies, and haircuts to over 6,000 children in Athens County. BTSB was created with the mission to ensure every child in the county feels confident about returning to school and has the necessary items to succeed. Registered students receive brand-name gym shoes, school-logo clothing, backpacks, school supplies, haircuts, and more. This initiative is partly funded by federal outreach dollars, but it also relies on the generosity of local community members and business partners.
